ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 159.02 OF THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES REGARDING RECREATION COMMISSION MEMBERSHIP

WHEREAS, Section 6.04 of the Village of Greenhills Charter provides for a Recreation Commission, to consist of seven members, as established by ordinance of Council; and

WHEREAS, Section 159.02 of the Greenhills Codified Ordinances currently governs the appointments for membership of the Recreation Commission; and

WHEREAS, Council for the Village of Greenhills has determined that it is in the best interest of the Village to modify the appointment process to the Recreation Commission to provide additional opportunities for Village resident representation.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Council of the Village of Greenhills, Ohio,
4 members elected thereto concurring:

Section 1. That the Council of the Village of Greenhills hereby amends Section 159.02 of the Codified Ordinances as set forth herein:

The Recreation Commission shall consist of seven residents appointed by the Mayor with the approval of Council. The Commission shall serve for the term of three years or until their successors are appointed, except that the members of such Commission first appointed shall be appointed for such terms that the term of two members shall expire annually thereafter. The members of such Commission shall serve without pay and vacancies shall be for the unexpired term and such vacancies shall be filled in the same manner as original appointments.

Section 2. That the remaining provisions of Chapter 159 shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 3. That this Ordinance shall be and is effective from and after the earliest period allowed by law.







159.01 CREATION AND PURPOSE.

There is hereby created within the Municipality, a Recreation Commission which shall, through the Municipal Manager, serve as an advisory board to advise the Council regarding the recreation needs of the Municipality.
 (Ord. 82-32R. Passed 5-18-82.)

159.02 MEMBERS AND TERMS.

The Recreation Commission shall consist of seven persons: five members shall be appointed by the Mayor and two Council members shall be elected by Council. The Commission shall serve for the term of three years or until their successors are appointed, except that the members of such Commission first appointed shall be appointed for such terms that the term of two members shall expire annually thereafter. The members of such Commission shall serve without pay and vacancies shall be for the unexpired term and such vacancies shall be filled in the same manner as original appointments. (Ord. 94-19R. Passed 5-3-94.)

159.03 OFFICERS: RULES AND REGULATIONS.

The members of the Recreation Commission shall elect their own chairman and secretary and select all other necessary officers from their members to serve for a period of one year. The Commission shall have power to adopt rules and regulations for the conduct of all business within its jurisdiction as an advisory board to Council. (Ord. 82-32R. Passed 5-18-82.)

159.04 EXPENSES; TAXATION.

Taxes collected pursuant to the recreation levy shall be restricted to recreation purposes only. All expenses incurred in the operation of any activities necessary to meet the recreation needs of the residents of the Municipality shall be payable from the treasury of the Municipality pursuant to Ordinance No. 82-15S. Council may annually appropriate and cause to be raised by taxation an amount for the purpose of equipping, operating, supervising and maintaining all existing public playgrounds athletic fields, golf courses, swimming pools, tennis courts, baseball diamonds, indoor recreation centers and other recreational facilities on or in any public grounds or buildings owned by the Municipality or on or in any public grounds hereafter acquired, which the Council may from this time authorize, designate, restrict or set apart for such use. (Ord. 82-32 R. Passed 5-18-82.)

159.05 POWERS OF MUNICIPAL MANAGER.

The Municipal Manager shall have all necessary authority to provide for the full-time supervision and control of the recreation needs of the Municipality and shall have the authority to employ any and all necessary personnel to provide for the recreation needs of the Municipality. (Ord. 82-32 R. Passed 5-18-82.)
