

ORDINANCE

AUTHORIZING THE MUNICIPAL MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT FOR THE PURCHASE OF TWO FIRE DEPARTMENT AMBULANCE CHASSIS BY COMPETITIVE BIDDING AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Municipal Manager shall keep the Mayor and Village Council fully advised as to the financial condition, future operating, and capital needs of the Municipality and make such recommendations to the Council concerning the affairs of the Municipality as the Municipal Manager deems desirable, or as requested by Council; and

WHEREAS, the Manager shall see that all laws, provisions of this Charter, and ordinances and resolutions of the Council, imposing duties on the Manager or employees subject to the Manager's direction and supervision, are faithfully executed; and

WHEREAS, the Manager shall be the contracting and purchasing officer of the Municipality and shall award and execute contracts and agreements on behalf of the Municipality in the manner and under the procedures required by this Charter; and

WHEREAS, Section 5.08 of the Village Charter provides that when the expenditure of funds for the purchase of supplies, equipment, or materials, or to provide labor for any work to be performed under a contract for a public improvement, exceeds the amount specified by the laws of the State of Ohio for which such purchases or work may be accomplished without advertisement and competitive bidding, such expenditure shall first be authorized and directed by Ordinance passed by Council. The Manager may award a written contract to the lowest and best bidder after advertisement on the same day of each week for not less than two nor more than four consecutive weeks in a newspaper determined by the Council to be of circulation within the Municipality; and

WHEREAS, the Manager shall perform the duties and have the powers as conferred or required by this Charter, by any Ordinance or Resolution of the Council, or by the laws of the State of Ohio, the Village Council has reviewed the proposed expenditures and scope of work to be performed and deems it in the best interest of the Village to enter into a contract for the purchase of two Fire Department Ambulance Chassis, pursuant to the terms and conditions set forth herein.


NOW THEREFORE, be it ordained by the affirmative vote of at least a majority of all members of the Council of the Village of Greenhills, Ohio 5 members elected thereto concurring:

Section 1: That the Municipal Manager is hereby authorized and directed, on behalf of the Village of Greenhills, to enter into a contract for the purchase of two Fire Department Ambulance Chassis, having received competitive bids and abided by all requirement of the Charter of Greenhills for purchasing including the terms for advertisement of such bids for the stipulated equipment.


Section 2: That given the unforeseen and unusual circumstances, and specialized equipment required for the Ambulance Remounting Project, these Ambulance Chassis will cease production during 2009 and must be ordered by no later than November 20, 2009, at which time thereafter such equipment will no longer be available resulting in extraordinary additional costs to the Village for acquisition of such lifesaving equipment.

Section 3: That this Ordinance is hereby declared an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety of the municipality. The reason for said declaration of emergency and expenditure of funds is to allow for the necessary purchase of this lifesaving equipment for the two Fire Department Ambulance Chassis, and therefore, this Ordinance shall take effect upon its adoption by the affirmative vote of at least a majority of all the members of Council.


