ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MUNICIPAL MANAGER TO AWARD THE 2010 INSURANCE COVERAGE FOR THE VILLAGE OF GREENHILLS AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the insurance for the Village of Greenhills will expire on January 1, 2010, and

WHEREAS, it is necessary the Village of Greenhills have continuous insurance coverage;

NOW THEREFORE, be it ordained by Council for the Village of Greenhills, State of Ohio, that:

Section 1. The insurance policies written by Morgan, Hoffman Insurance Agency for the issuance of automobile, general liability, police professional liability, public officials liability, property insurance, and other insurance as determined by the Municipal Manager in the name of the Village of Greenhills, is hereby awarded for one year in an amount not to exceed Fifty-Five Thousand Four Hundred Twenty-Five dollars (\$55,425.00). A copy of the policy is on file with the Finance Director.

Section 2. The Municipal Manager is hereby authorized and directed to execute any and all documents necessary to implement said coverage.


Section 3. The expenditure of up to Fifty-Five Thousand Four Hundred Twenty-Five dollars (\$55,425.00) for 2010 is hereby authorized and directed by the Municipal Manager.


Section 4. Morgan Hoffman Insurance Agency is hereby authorized to render professional consultation with respect to insurance coverage for 2010.

Section 5. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency Ordinance necessary for the public health, safety, and welfare and shall take effect immediately. The reason for said emergency is the need to continue insurance coverage which will expire January 1, 2010.
